EDUCATIONAL UPDATE



Educators will tell you that it's difficult to teach a hungry child. By providing daily nutritious food for the children, you are assisting in their educational experience. TIOF continues to provide food for all 6 of the sites it supports.

A tutor has been provided for about 9-12 girls at Orfanitorio Mazatlan. Here is an excerpt from the last tutor report (sent exactly as received by the tutor).

She arrives the institution

on September 2016, she is on fourth grade, however she doesn't read or write, she is on a pre-syllabic process, she knows the sound and the handwriting of m,p,s,l,t and vowels She has a good handwriting when copying a text. She just can add or subtract 1 or 2 digits....

February 2017

She has made great progress on reading,...She has a remarkable

handwriting. She is learning multiplication tables...

Additionally, one of young ladies won 1st place for her report on sustainable tourism.

She went from *...struggle with some texts...* in May to *"She got the best grades, her average from 9th grade was 9.5..."* in September.

SPRING MISSION WEEK





Spring Mission Week will be here before we know it. This coming spring, the dates are March 10-17. If you are considering going, please email Phyllis & Bruce Allen.
